About Electra-fying

The Plane

Lockheed Electra 1026 was delivered brand new to Braniff Airlines in June 1935 and quickly became the backbone of the company. Over the next four decades the aircraft would trade hands multiple times before eventually ending up with Provincetown-Boston Airline (eventually Naples Airlines & Provincetown-Boston Airline). The Electra has been sitting in a hangar for the last 25-30 years.

The goal is to restore the aircraft to flying status and operate it as a traveling, interactive, educational exhibit. Thanks to the hands-on nature of this project we will be allowing visitors inside and around the Electra.

The Electra will be flown to air shows, fly-ins, and community events and we hope will be the center of attention at any events held here in Topeka.

An educational program is being developed for use in connection with the Electra to teach students about the Electra's history, its effect on aviation, the airline industry, and Amelia Earhart.







About Electra-fying

Educational Program

- Teach students about the Lockheed Electra and its place in history.
 - This includes the plane's effect on air travel, the airline/aviation industry, and the 1930s (also known as "the golden age of aviation).
- Discuss changes in aircraft/aviation over the past 90 years.
- Amelia Earhart
 - Earhart's connection to the Electra
 - She used a highly modified Model 10 Electra on her illfated 1937 world flight attempt.
 - Present photos so students can compare Earhart's Electra configuration to that of the standard passenger configuration.
 - Explain what modifications were made to prepare Amelia's plane for the long flight ahead.
 - Spread Amelia's message: you don't have to live the life society expects you to live and that through hard work and determination you can achieve your dreams.
